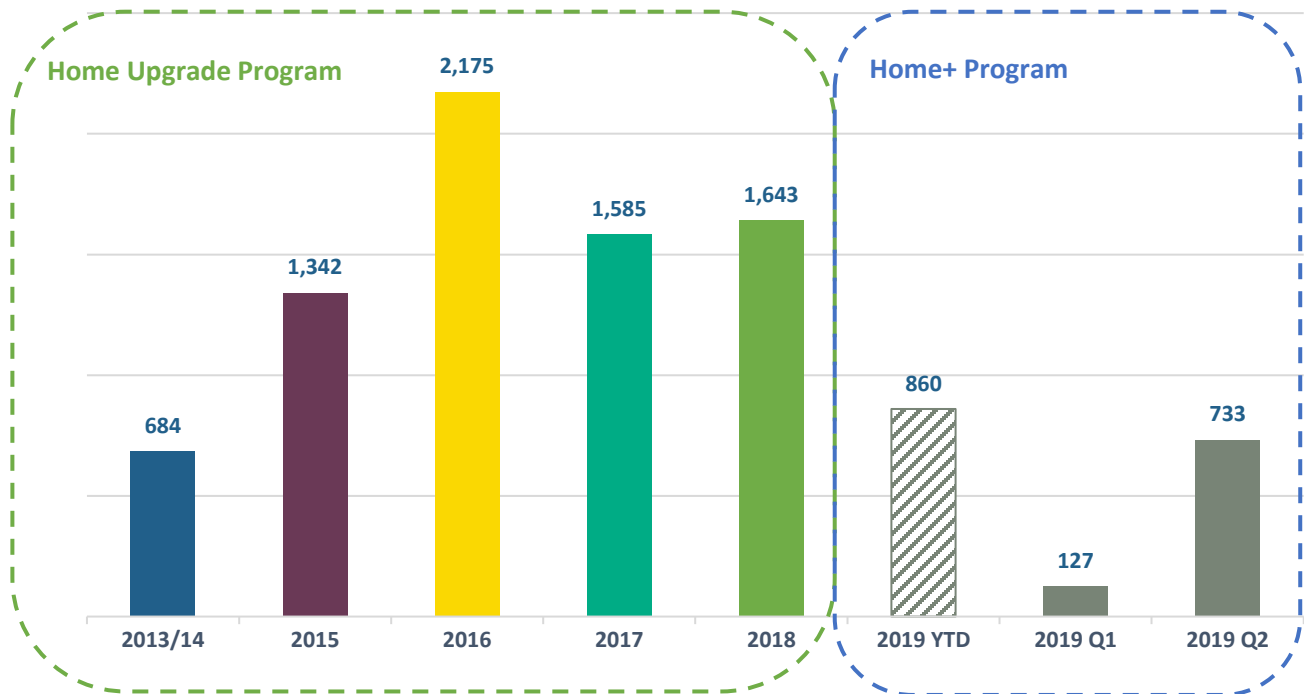


The Bay Area Regional Energy Network (BayREN) implements effective energy saving programs on a regional level and draws on the expertise, experience, and proven track record of Bay Area local governments to develop and administer successful climate, resource, and sustainability programs. BayREN is a collaboration of the 9 counties that make up the San Francisco Bay Area.

Single Family

A total of \$1,198,800 incentives were paid through the new Home+ program to 860 individual homes through June in 2019. This translated to an average incentive of \$1,394 per home. 129 customers also completed the online home evaluation. 65 of these customers received the no-cost EE kits for sharing their energy usage data with the program.

Codes & Standards

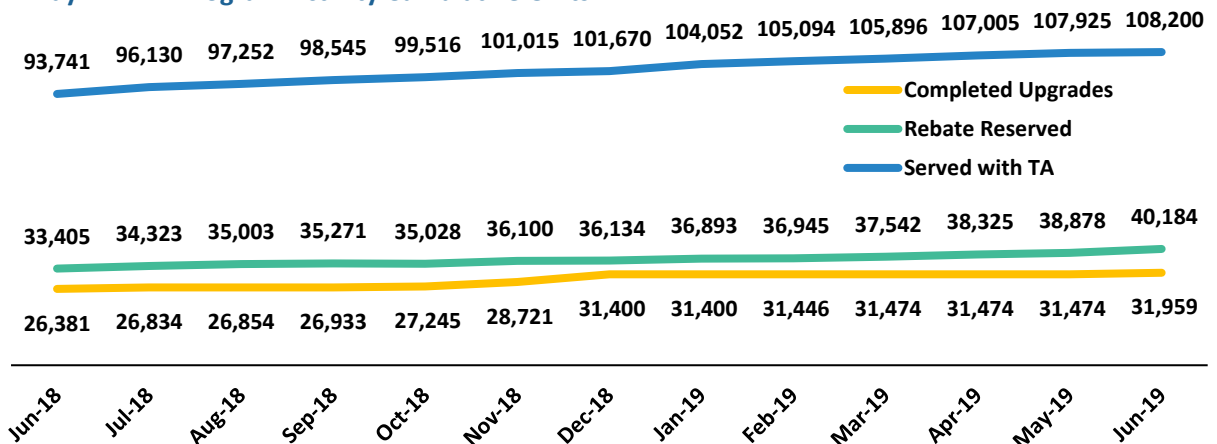

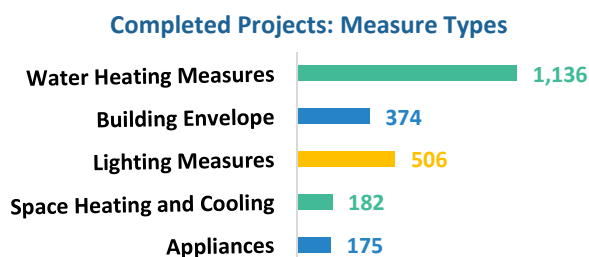
Multifamily

The BayREN Multifamily program offers property owners free technical assistance and rebates of \$750 per unit for saving 15% or more of their whole building's energy usage. The program is extremely popular, and to date, 31,959 units have completed, receiving \$23,968,422 in rebates.
